

TOWN OF LONDONDERRY
Possession of former Frog's Leap Inn
Legal Notice

The Town of Londonderry ("Town") took possession of the former Frog's Leap Inn located at 7455 VT Route 100 following a tax sale process. The Town acknowledged the presence of a holdover tenant at the premises, known as Robert Zmayerski. Upon Mr. Zmayerski quitting the premises, certain vehicles were left on the premises which Mr. Zmyerski stated he may return to claim. On July 28, 2017 the Town sold the lands and premises at 7455 VT Route 100 to a third party. The vehicles stored at 7455 VT Route 100 are being stored by the Town at the Transfer Station.

Pursuant to the terms of 9 V.S.A. §4462(c)(1) the above described vehicles will be stored for sixty (60) days from the date of this publication. If Mr. Zmayerski does not claim the vehicles by December 11, 2017 by 5:00 pm, the Town will treat the vehicles as unclaimed, and the vehicles will become the property of the Town. This publication is intended to provide notice to former holdover tenant Robert Zmayerski.
