The Town of Ludlow received \$750,000 from the State of Vermont for a grant under the Vermont Community Development Program. A public hearing will be held at Town Offices, 37 Depot Street, Ludlow, VT 05149 on 2/6/2017 at 7:00 PM to obtain the views of citizens on community development, to furnish information concerning the range of community development activities that have been undertaken under this program, and to give affected citizens the opportunity to examine a statement of the use of these funds. The VCDP Funds received have been used to accomplish the following activities:

The Town of Ludlow received a VCDP Grant for the Housing Trust of Rutland County to make water and wastewater improvements at the Tuckerville Mobile Home Park on Tuckerville Parkway. HTRC is a non-profit affordable housing organization who owns the mobile home park and entered into a Subgrant Agreement with the Town for the purpose of implementing and managing the project. HTRC has been working subsequently to identify and attract low and moderate income Ludlow area residents looking for homeownership in a mobile home park to lease the remaining vacant lots.
