Notice of Public Hearing

The Londonderry Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on June 26, 2017 from 5:30 to 7:00PM at the Town Office, Twitchell Building, at 100 Old School Street, So. Londonderry.

The purpose of the hearing is to hear public comment on the proposed Town Plan. The purpose of the Town Plan is to provide objectives for responsible growth and development based upon a shared vision and public commitment to preserve natural resources, historic settlement patterns, the vitality of the north and south villages and quality of life for those who choose to live here. The Town Plan is a planning tool intended to guide the decisions of municipal government and citizens.

The 2017 Town Plan update applies to all geographic areas of the town. This proposed Plan considers state requirements, current conditions and trends, known and anticipated future needs and objectives, public input from a 2016 community forum and lessons learned from the impacts of Tropical Storm Irene. The Plan contains eight sections with individual discussion, goals, policies and actions for the next eight years together with relevant maps.
