NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Rockingham, Vermont is considering making application to the State of Vermont for an Implementation Grant under the Vermont Community Development Program (VCDP). A public hearing will be held in the Lower Theater meeting room at the Rockingham Town Hall, 7 Square, Bellows Falls, VT on July 18th, 2017 at 6:30 pm to obtain the views of citizens on community development; to furnish information concerning the amount of funds available and the range of community development activities that may be undertaken under this program; to review the impact to any historic and archaeological resources that may be affected by the proposed project; and to give affected citizens the opportunity to examine the proposed statement of projected use of these funds. The proposal is to apply for a maximum of \$425,000 in VCDP Funds which will be used for building demolition and hazardous material abatement at the former Robertson Mill location on Island Street. This effort would alleviate a blighted portion of downtown Bellows Falls and provide for future commercial development opportunities.
