


ACT 250 NOTICE
MINOR APPLICATION #2W1345
10 V.S.A. §§ 6001 – 6093

On July 31, 2017, the Preservation Trust of Vermont, 104 Church St., Burlington, VT 05401, the Windham Foundation, PO Box 72, Grafton, VT 05146, and the Vermont Dept. of Fish & Wildlife, One National Life Dr., Montpelier, VT 05620 filed application #2W1345 for a project generally described as restoring the historic Birchdale Camp Cabin, constructing a gravel pedestrian path, and installing interpretive signs to operate as an un-staffed historic site. The State of VT will be creating a five-acre parcel for the historic site that will be conveyed to the Windham Foundation. The project is located at 747 Turner Hill Road in Grafton, Vermont.

No hearing will be held and a permit will be issued unless, on or before September 5, 2017, a party notifies the District #2 Commission in writing at the address below of an issue requiring a hearing or the Commission sets the matter for hearing on its own motion. Such hearing request must include a petition for party status. The application and proposed permit may also be viewed on the Natural Resources Board's web site (<http://nrb.vermont.gov/>) by clicking "Act 250 Database" and entering the project number #2W1345.
