

Proposed Invasive Plant Control Measures

The Vermont Department of Forests, Parks and Recreation proposes to conduct treatments to control invasive exotic plants on properties owned by the State of Vermont in Windsor and Windham Counties. These will include but are not limited to: Amity Pond Natural Area, Pomfret; Mollie Beattie State Forest, Grafton; Mt. Ascutney State Park, Weathersfield and Windsor; Muckross State Park, Springfield; Williams River State Forest, Chester; Windsor Grasslands Wildlife Management Area, Windsor.

The proposed treatment area will not exceed 80 acres in size total. Application will include foliar and cut stem methods utilizing Round-up, Rodeo or Triclopyr. Treatment will occur between the 5/15/2021 and 10/1/2021, and each site will have signage displayed for additional public notice.
