

**ACT 250 NOTICE**  
**MINOR APPLICATION #2S1374**  
**10 V.S.A. §§ 6001 – 6093**

On September 21, 2021, S+K Odyssey, LLC, 237 Randall Hill Rd, Springfield, VT 05156 filed application 2S1374 for a project generally described as the construction of three canvas tents on platforms supported by wooden posts cemented into the ground. The project is located 237 Randall Hill in Springfield, Vermont. No hearing will be held and a permit will be issued unless, on or before Tuesday, November 02, 2021, a party notifies the District 2 Commission in writing at the address below of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing to the address below, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law may not be prepared unless the Commission holds a public hearing. The application and proposed permit may also be viewed on the Natural Resources Board's web site (<http://nrb.vermont.gov>) by clicking "Act 250 Database" and entering project number 2S1374.
