


ACT 250 NOTICE
MINOR APPLICATION #2S1375
10 V.S.A. §§ 6001 – 6093

On October 28, 2021, Parker Hill Farm, LLC, Peter A. Fuller and Patricia J. Fuller, 481 Parker Hill Rd, Springfield, VT 05156 filed application 2S1375 for a project generally described as the addition of amenities to existing five-unit “glamping” campground including outdoor kitchen, camp store, trout fishing, outdoor seating area, and similar to serve campground guests only. The project is located 481 Parker Hill rd in Springfield, Vermont. No hearing will be held and a permit will be issued unless, on or before Tuesday, December 14, 2021, a party notifies the District 2 Commission in writing at the address below of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing to the address below, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law may not be prepared unless the Commission holds a public hearing. The application and proposed permit may also be viewed on the Natural Resources Board’s web site (<http://nrb.vermont.gov>) by clicking “Act 250 Database” and entering project number 2S1375. If you have a disability for which you need accommodation in order to participate in this process (including participating in a public hearing, if one is held), please notify us as soon as possible, in order to allow us as much time as possible to accommodate your needs.
